Dr Timothy M. Vogel is professor of Microbiology and Environmental Engineering at the University of Lyon, France. He received BS degrees in Geology and Oceanography at the University of Washington and his MSE and PhD in Environmental Engineering at Stanford University. He has worked for 30 years on microbial adaptation to environmental contaminants and has over 70 scientific publications and 8 patents. He works as a consultant for both environmental consulting firms and various biotech industries, was on the faculties of Michigan State University and the University of Michigan, and was scientific expert for environmental biotechnology at Rhône-Poulenc for 8 years. He is a partner in recent biotechnology start-up, ENOVEO. Over the last few years, he has developed an active metagenomics research group and co-founded the International Terragenome consortium for the complete sequencing of the soil metagenome.
